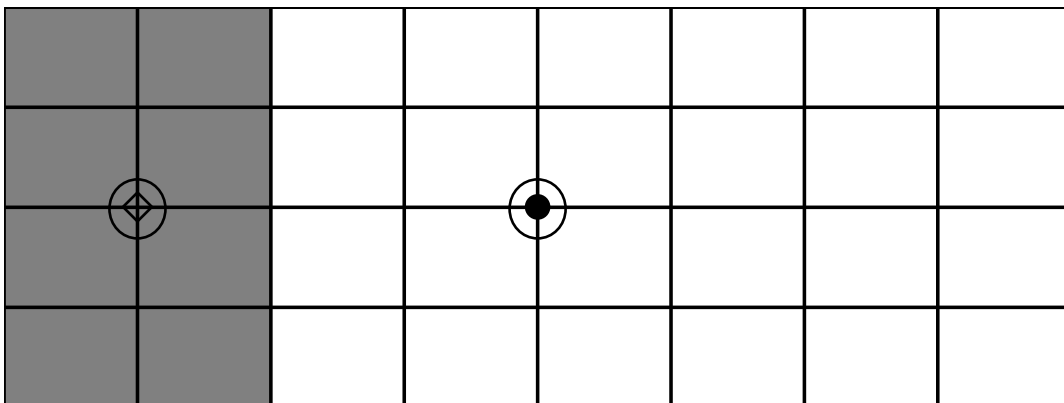

Attempts to overlap some L^AT_EX code onto a PDF image. In the centre of each area is a callout symbol.



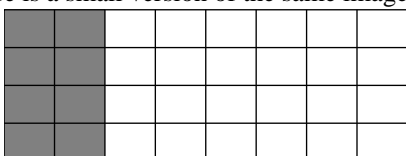
Descriptions:

◊. This callout refers to an area that occupies the shaded region of the image.

●. This callout refers to a point that is located in the centre of the image.

◊ and ●. This callout refers both the previous areas.

Line 2. This callout refers to the second line.

Lines 1–3. This callout refers to all lines.
